## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61924 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bob Angell, Inc. and Angell Asphalt and Aggregate, Inc. of 641 Sixth Avenue, Eastside, Oregon 97420, phone 269-1888, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Joe Cox Creek, for the PURPOSE of industrial use in rock crusher and asphalt plant; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 19, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 250 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,200 feet South and 2,100 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 12, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 31 South Range 15 West, WM Section 12 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Industriel use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
