## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62333 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Alvin R. Kreger of Route 1, Box 112, Pendleton, Oregon 97801, phone 276-1481, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, Umatilla River, and North Forty Pond to be constructed under Application R-62332, Permit R-8375, tributeries of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 17, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1 (Umatilla River) - 1,200 feet</u> East and 100 feet South; <u>Diversion 2 and 3 (Unnamed Spring and North Forty Pond) - 1,250 feet</u> East and 300 feet South; all from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 2 North, Range 33 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North Range 33 East, WM Section 8 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 5.1 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8375 for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
