PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62252 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Wallace F. Bullock of Route 1, Box 64, Milton-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-5029, for the use of the waters of South Fork Walla Walla River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 12, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 460 feet East from the WI/4 Corner of Section 22 and being on the East-West center line between the SWI/4 NWI/4 and the NWI/4 SWI/4 said Section 22, Township 5 North, Range 36 East, WM, in the County of Umatilia.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 North Range 36 East, WM Section 22 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 7.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 3/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
