PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62548 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Pamela Kaye Hallcraft of 2540 NE Kerr Street, Space 6, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-6739, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the supply of water from the stream to be made up by appropriation from a spring, tributaries of Little River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 4, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion I (Spring)</u> - 60 feet South and 115 feet West; <u>Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream)</u> - 450 feet South and 400 feet West, both from the Center Corner of Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South Range 3 West, WM Section 33 NE 1/4 SW 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
