## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61232 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Merlyn W. and Irene Langford of 1016 South Fourth Street, Union, Oregon 97883, phone 562-5674, for the use of the waters of Catherine Creek, a tributary of Grande Ronde River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 8, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 157.5 feet South and 1,866 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 19, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 4 South, Range 40 East, WM, in the County of Union.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South Range 39 East, WM Section 24 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
