PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61836 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mervin Leonard c/o Bob Levy of PO Box 611, Echo, Oregon 97826, phone 567-8900, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream with any deficiency to be supplied by Westland Irrigation District wastewater provided the total diversion will not exceed 5.12 cubic feet per second of water, tributaries of Umatilla River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 25, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.12 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Westland Ditch) - 1,060 feet North and 80 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33; Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream) - 1,320 feet North and 60 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 33, both being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 5 North, Range 28 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
