PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60383 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Michael Dussault of PO Box 221, Sixes, Oregon 97476, for the use of the waters of Dussault Creek and Michelle Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63537, Permit R-8392, tributaries of Sixes River, for the PURPOSE of domestic supplies for three families, irrigation and fish culture, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from Dussault Creek for domestic supplies, 0.13 cfs from Dussault Creek for irrigation and 2.3 cfs from Dussault Creek for maintaining Michelle Reservoir for fish culture; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 12, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.44 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Dussault Creek) - 1,500 feet South and 140 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, and Diversion 2 (Michelle Reservoir) - 1,900 feet South and 460 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, both being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 32 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South Range 14 West, WM Section 10 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 10.0 acres irrigation, domestic use for three families and fish culture

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8392, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
