PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60713 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Leonard w. Evans of Route 3, Box 445-G, Hillsboro, Oregon 97123, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of East Fork McKay Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrication of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RICHT dates from September 17, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 9.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT Or DIVERSION is to be LUCATED: 780 feet South and 225 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 16, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North Range 2 West, WM Section 9 SE 1/4 Sw 1/4

Demestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area

Water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year, except for human and livestock consumption.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
