### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62822 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clifford and Martha Melloof of 528 Crystal Drive, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 862-2479, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 22, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 725 feet South and 650 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

Applegate Lake Reservoir is located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South Range 6 West, WM Section 31 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contact 2-07-10-W0416 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
