## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62832 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joann Wanner of Box 182-A, Tye Road, Umpqua, Oregon 97486, phone 459-5148, for the use of the waters of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 24, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,170 feet North and 1,780 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South Range 7 West, WM Section 9 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
