PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60510 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Loretta Carol Braun of 7335 SE 64th, Portland, Oregon 97206, phone 771-2342, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Sandlake, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 18, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 872.4 feet North and 1,161.5 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 29, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South Range 10 West, WM Section 29 SW 1/4 SW 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
