PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61238 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Paul David and Dolly Mae Miller of 86126 Sweet Creek Road, Mapleton, Oregon 97453, phone 268-4338, for the use of the waters of Bradley Creek, a tributary of Sweet Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 12, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed <u>0.01</u> cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 555 feet North and 330 feet West from the Center Guarter Corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 18 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South Range 18 West, WM Section 28 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
