## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61588 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James Jackson of Route 2, Box 306, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-3294, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Bear Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, temperature control, and flood harvesting, being 0.14 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation, 1.68 cfs for temperature control, and 0.56 cfs for flood harvesting; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 23, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.68 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,560 feet North and 1,900 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South Range 14 West, WM Section 28 NE 1/4 NE 1/4

1.25 acres irrigation, temperature control, and flood harvesting in Bogs I and 6.

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 4.25 acres irrigation, temperature control, and flood harvesting in Bogs 7, 8, and 13. 3.00 acres temperature control and flood harvesting in Bogs 9,

10, and 14.

0.7 acre temperature control and flood harvesting in Bog 15.

SE 1/4

NE 1/4 0.25 acre irrigation. temperature control, and flood harvesting in a portion of Bog 7. 1.75 acres temperature control and flood harvesting in Bog 16.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost protection) one forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
