## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62963 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to M. Millicent Williamson of 17440 SE Highway 224, Clacksmas, Oregon 97015, phone 658-6708, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Clackamas River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 12, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 450 feet North and 1,300 feet East from the Center Guarter Corner of Section 18, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM, In the County of Clackemas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South Range 3 East, WM Section 18 NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
