PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62984 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George and Geraldine Hershberger of PO Box 121, Waldport, Oregon 97394, phone 563-3068, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Alsea River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 16, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LUCATED: 225.2 feet South and 294.2 feet West from the E1/4 Corner of Section 27, being within the NE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 27, Township 13 South, Range II West, WM, in the County of Lincoln.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South Range 11 West, WM Section 27 NE 1/4 SE 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
