## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63005 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kenneth R. Gough of Amity Route 1, Box 192A, Amity, Oregon 97101, phone 835-2503, for the use of the waters of Ash Swale, a tributary of South Yamhill River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 30, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 420 feet North and 760 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 32, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 South Range 4 West, WM Section 32 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 4.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
