PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63023 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gregory Snow of 528 Lomas Road, Jacksonville, Oregon 97530, phone 899-8071, for the use of the waters of Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of fish culture; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 5, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 540 feet South and 1,660 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 3 West, WM Section 33 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Fish culture Township 39 South Range 3 West, WM Section 4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Fish culture

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
