PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63045 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lee Merriman of 4604 Highway 66, Ashland, Oregon 97520, phone 482-1940, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Grizzly Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 16, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,420 feet South and 1,200 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 22, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 3 East, WM Section 22 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
