PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63110 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions

This permit is issued to Mark Rice of PO Box 850, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 863-4448, for the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek, a tributary of Myrtle Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and stock use, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.005 cfs for stock use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 10, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,800 feet South and 2,630 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 22, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South Range 4 West, Wird Section 22 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family and stock use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
