## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63114 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John Tyrholm of Box 548, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 247-7490, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Cedar Fork Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 335 feet South and 763 feet East from the West Guarter Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 35 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South Range 14 West, WM Section 16 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for two families

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
