## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63183 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jack D. Cornwell of 4701 Wintler Drive, Vancouver, Washington 98661, phone (206)694-6286, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Wallows River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and campsite domestic use, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for campsite domestic use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 18, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 220 feet South and 120 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Wallows.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South Range 45 East, WM Section 28 5W1/4 NW1/4 0.5 acre irrigation and campsite domestic use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
