PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63209 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BUARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Hollis Gunter of 376 Bonnie Lane, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-8646, for the use of the waters of Louse Creek and an unnamed reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63035, Permit R-8398, for the PURPOSE of recreation; that the PRICRITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 4, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,000 feet North and 720 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 35 South Range 5 West, WM Section 30 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Recreation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
