PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61176 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dave H. Brooks, dba Brookhill Farms of Oregon of Route 1, Box 906, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-9296, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Laurel Lake, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation, supplemental temperature control and supplemental flood harvesting, being 1.0 cubic foot of water per second for supplemental irrigation, 6.0 cfs for supplemental temperature control and 2.0 cfs for supplemental flood harvesting; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 5, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6.0 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 530 feet North and 1,430 feet West from the Center Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 29 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South	Range 15 West, WM	Section 25	NE 1/4	NW 1/4	10.0 acres supplemental irrigation, supplemental temperature control and supplemental flood harvesting
			SE 1/4	NW 1/4	30.0 acres supplemental irrigation, supplemental temperature control and supplemental flood harvesting

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control on forms furnished.

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
