PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61265 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Tal B. Calkins of Box 189, Sitkum Route, Coquille, Oregon 97458, phone 396-5184, for the use of the waters of East Fork Coquille River and Weekly Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.38 cubic foot of water per second from East Fork Coquille River for irrigation, 0.005 cfs from East Fork Coquille River for domestic use and 0.15 cfs from Weekly Creek for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 19, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.535 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion I (East Fork Coching Rier) - 2,050 feet North and 1,280 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 30, being within the NW I/4 SW I/4 of Section 30; Diversion 2 (Weekly Creek) - 950 feet North and 2,315 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 30, being within the SE I/4 SW I/4 of Section 30; Diversion 3 (East Fork Coquille River) - 1,490 feet North and 800 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 30, being within the NW I/4 SW I/4 of Section 30, all being within Township 28 South, Range II West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
