"CERTIFICATE NO. _ PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61942 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Henry and Erika Arndt of Route 2, Box 94, Gaston, Oregon 97119, phone 985-7724, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Wapotoe Lake (Tualatin River), for the PURPOSE of irrigation, stock water and domestic use for one family, being 0.06 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation, 0.005 cfs for stock water and 0.005 cfs for domestic use; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from July 22, 1981 for 0.06 cfs and March 22, 1982 for 0.01 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.07 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human and livestock consumption.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,600 feet South and 1,800 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South Range 3 West, WM Section 8

NW 1/4 NW 1/4

4.5 acres irrigation, stock use and domestic use for

one family

NE 1/4 NW 1/4

0.5 acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
