### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62416 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Michael J. and Bonne F.H. Swett of Route 1, Box 92-B, Riddle, Oregon 97469, phone 874-3283, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Cow Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from August 27, 1981 for 0.5 gallon of water per minute and June 4, 1982 for 3.5 gpm, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.0 gpm measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,200 feet North and 100 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South Range 6 West, WM Section 25 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.9 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
