PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63058 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Myron E. Vloek of 714 East 9th Street, Coquille, Oregon 97423, phone 396-3648 or 396-2163, for the use of the waters of North Umpqua River, a tributery of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 23, 1961, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,254 feet South and 480 feet West from the Guarter Corner common to Sections 2 and 11, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Dougles.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South Range 3 West, WM Section 11 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
