PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62811 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Claude H. Gudge of PO Box 66, Welches, Oregon 97067, phone 622-3154, for the use of the waters of Salmon River, a tributary of Sandy River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 21, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 160 feet South and 475 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 3 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South Range 7 East, WM Section 16 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for
two families

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
