PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63251 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Georgia E. Domogalla of 2691 Gray Oak Lane, Salem, Oregon 97302, phone 362-1391, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Pettyjohn Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 10, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 90 feet North and 400 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 5, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 8 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 8 South Range 3 West, WM Section 5 SE 1/4 NW 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
