## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63261 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Melqua Home Owners Association, by Mark M. Sterner of 1772 Melqua Road, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-2047 or 673-8883, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by appropriation of water from Umpqua River and two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-63260, Permit R-8411, for the PURPOSE of fire protection; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 16, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LUCATED: Diversion I(Umpqua River) - 700 feet South and 250 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 31, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31; Diversion 2(Reservoir I) - 585 feet South and 995 West from the Northeast Corner of Section 31, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31; and Diversion 3(Reservoir 2) -1,780 feet South and 885 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31, all being within Township 26 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South Range 6 West, WM Section 31 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Fire protection and reservoir maintenance NW 1/4 NE 1/4 rire protection SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Fire protection NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Fire protection and reservoir maintenance

This permit shall be limited to maintaining the fire suppression system and to periods of actual fire emergency.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1. 1985.
