PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63331 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Catherine Maurer of Box 8, Antelope, Oregon 97001, phone 489-3282, for the use of the waters of two springs, for the PURPOSE of stock water; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 1, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed $\underline{0.01}$ cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the springs, being $\underline{0.005}$ cfs from each spring, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 4,130 feet South and 440 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 4, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, and Diversion 2 - 3,400 feet North and 910 feet East from the S1/4 Corner of Section 12, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, both within Township 8 South, Range 18 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 South Range 18 East, WM Section 4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Stock water from Spring 1
Section 12 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Stock water from Spring 2

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
