PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60518 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lavern and Carmelita Miller of 5058 Booth Hill Road, Hood River, Oregon 97031, phone 354-1221, for the use of the waters of a spring and an unnamed stream, tributaries of Neal Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and supplemental irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic supplies and 0.0125 cfs for supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 1, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0175 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1(Spring) - 963 feet North and 1,176 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 11 and Diversion 2(Unnamed Stream) - 1,188 feet North and 1,176 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 11, both being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 1 North, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North	Range 10 East, WM	Section 11	SW 1/4	SW 1/4	Domestic use for one family and irrigation of 3.0 acres
			SE 1/4	SW 1/4	Irrigation of 8.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
