PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62379 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Peter Van Waardenberg of 1395 Fish Hatchery Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 474-2031, for the use of the waters of Applegate River for irrigation and Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810 for supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 8, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, and 2.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 560 feet South and 910 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 15, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

Applegate Dam is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South	Range 6 West, WM	Section 15	NE 1/4	SE 1/4	Primary from <u>Applegate River</u> 1.0 acre
			NE 1/4	SE 1/4	Supplemental from <u>Applegate Lake Reservoir</u> 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre from direct flow, and shall further be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 2-07-10-W0463 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
