## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63311 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is Issued to Glen W. and Betty Powers of 1309 King Street, Grandview, Washington 98930, phone (509)882-1495, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of North Fork Nehalem River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.025 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from February 22, 1982 for 0.025 cfs and June 7, 1982 for 0.005 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,187 feet South and 521 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 3 North, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 North Range 10 West, WM Section 13 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family and 2.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per scre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per scre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
