## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63589 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Steven Walter Johnson of PO Box 162, Beaver Creek, Oregon 97004, phone 632-6228, for the use of the waters of Beaver Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63588, Permit R-8439, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, stock water and recreation, being 0.025 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation, 0.005 cfs for stock water and 0.01 cfs for recreation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 28, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 50 feet North and 560 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 26, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South	Range 2 East, WM	Section 26	SE 1/4	NW 1/4	Recreation and stock uses and 0.3 acre irrigation
			NE 1/4	SW 1/4	1.7 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8439, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
