PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61161 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William A. Van Leer of Route 2, Box 184-A, Scappoose, Oregon 97056, phone 543-2550, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Cedar Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and operation of a ram, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.035 cfs for operation of a ram; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from January 19, 1981 for domestic use and May 9, 1982 for operation of a hydraulic ram, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 695 feet North and 455 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Columbia.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 North Range 2 West, WM Section 7 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for
one family and
operation of a ram

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
