## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62968 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Marvin H. and Joyce E. Mace of Star Route, Box 1035, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-4478, for the use of the waters of Fir Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-62967, Permit R-8442, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and stock water, being 0.10 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock water, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.105 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 675 feet North and 818 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I North Range 4 West, WM Section 5 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.83 acre Section 6 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 7.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8442, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for livestock consumption, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
