PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63428 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David K. Burks of Route 1, Box 704, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-5547, for the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 26, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.80 cubic foot of water per second from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,600 feet North and 1,060 feet West from the Corner common to Sections 20, 21, 29 and 28, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, and Diversion 2 - 910 feet North and 1,100 feet East from the Corner common to Sections 20, 21, 29 and 28, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, both within Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
