PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61113 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James Belt of Route 2, Lane 15, Burns, Oregon 97720, phone 493-2776, for the use of the waters of a slough, a tributary of Malheur Lake, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.96 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1</u> - 10 feet South and 660 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 2, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2; <u>Diversion 2</u> - 1,900 feet South and 10 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 2, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2; <u>Diversion 3</u> - 2,550 feet North and 10 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 2, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 2, all within Township 24 South, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Harney.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 38, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
