PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61333 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Byron W. and Jean C. Hawkins of Route 2, Box 2665, LaGrande, Oregon 97850, phone 963-0693, for the use of the waters of Gekeler Slough and Grande Ronde Valley Improvement District Tail Water Drain Ditch, being 3.5 cubic feet per second from the slough and 2.5 cfs from the Drain Ditch, tributaries of Ladd Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 18, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6.0 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 371 feet South and 1,691 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29; Diversion 2 - 50 feet South and 1,440 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29; Diversion 3 - 125 feet South and 3,500 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 29, all within Township 3 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Union.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
