PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61901 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Tom Shipler of Route 1, Box 1530, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-2757, for the use of the waters of two unnamed streams and Mill Creek, being 7.5 cubic feet per second of water from each unnamed stream with any deficiency to be made up by diversion from Mill Creek, tributaries of Floras Lake, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, flood harvesting, and temperature control of cranberries; being 2.5 cfs for irrigation, 5.5 cfs for flood harvesting, and 15.0 cfs for temperature control; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 15, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 15.0 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Unnamed Stream 2) - 5,270 feet North and 5,400 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30; Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream 1) - 5,270 feet North and 4,250 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29; Diversion 3 (Unnamed Stream 2) - 10,550 feet North and 4,350 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 4 (Mill Creek) - 10,550 feet North and 3,000 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, all within Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost protection) on forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986
