PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63024 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Milan N. Pond of Star Route 1, Box 3A, Grand Ronde, Oregon 97347, phone 879-5424, for the use of the waters of Four Springs, being 0.3 gallons per minute from Spring 1, 0.3 gpm from Spring 2, 0.116 gpm from Spring 3, and 0.117 gpm from Spring 4, tributaries of Agency Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family, stock, and irrigation, being 0.07 gpm for domestic use, 0.04 gpm for stock use, and 0.723 gpm for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 5, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.833 gallons per minute measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 250 feet South and 610 feet East; Diversion 2 - 330 feet South and 470 feet East; Diversion 3 - 420 feet South and 430 feet East; Diversion 4 - 380 feet South and 280 feet East, all from the Northwest Corner of Section 1, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South Range 8 West, WM Section 1 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family, 0.5 acre irrigation, and stock

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
