## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63324 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Tom Shipler of Route 1, Box 1530, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-2757, for the use of the waters of Unnamed Creek 3 with any deficiency to be supplied by Big Creek and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63330, Permit R-8449, tributaries of Floras Lake, for the PURPOSE of temperature control, irrigation, and flood harvesting, being 21.75 cubic feet per second for temperature control, 3.63 cfs for irrigation, and 2.25 cfs for flood harvesting, provided the total diverted does not exceed 21.75 cfs; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 21.75 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 3 - 2,400 feet South and 2,400 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 4 - 100 feet South and 500 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 5 (Dam) - 1,600 feet South and 100 feet East from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 21; Diversion 6 - 3,700 feet South and 1,200 feet East from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, all within Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8449, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost protection) on forms furnished.
