## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63546 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ronald G. Frashour of 300 Westwood Lane, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 673-6047, for the use of the waters of North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 17, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 720 feet South and 680 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South Range 6 West, WM Section 33 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.8 acres Section 28 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.6 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shell be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 16, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
