### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63213 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Larry W. and Shirley J. Gunter of 24850 SE Highway 212, Boring, Oregon 97009, phone 658-6618, for the use of the waters of Noyer Creek and Lake Michigan Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-63212, Permit R-8465 for the PURPOSE of irrigation and recreation, being 0.08 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation and 0.02 cfs for recreation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 13, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 650 feet South and 1,700 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South	Range 3 East, WM	Section 11	NE 1/4	NW 1/4	3.0 acres and recreation
			SE 1/4	NW 1/4	3.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-8465 and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
