## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63554 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James S. and Linda Shea Ford of 15001 North Applegate Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-7185, for the use of the waters of an unnamed slough and 7.0 acre-feet stored water from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation, being 0.125 cubic foot of water per second from the unnamed slough for irrigation and 7.0 acre-feet stored water only from Applegate Lake Reservoir for supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 20, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.125 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 740 feet South and 840 feet East from the N1/4 Corner of Section 7, being within the NW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 7, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

Applegate Dam is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Primary
Township 38 South Range 4 West, WM Section 7 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 10.0 acres

Supplemental

NW 1/4 NE 1/4

6.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 2-07-10-W0464 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
