PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62550 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Marilyn Dorsett of 12570 SW Morgan Road, Sherwood, Oregon 97140, phone 625-5070, for the use of the waters of unnamed springs and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-62549, Permit R-8468, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of a reservoir for fish culture and stock water, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for fish culture and 0.005 cfs for stock water; that the $\overline{PRIORITY}$ OF THE RIGHT dates from September 4, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,340 feet North and 200 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 4, being within the NE I/4 SE I/4 of Section 4, Township 3 South, Range I West, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South Range I West, WM Section 4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Fish culture and stock water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
