PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63643 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles Madden of 233 Rocky Road, Trail, Oregon 97541, phone 878-3153, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of Trail Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 17, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,190 feet North and 1,985 feet East from the Southeast Corner of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 33 South, Range I West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South Range I West, WM Section 29 NE I/4 NE I/4 Domestic use for

Domestic use for one family including lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation not exceding one-half acre in area

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
