PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63691 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to C.E. Miller of Route 3, Box 554, Corvallis, Oregon 97330, for the use of the waters of an unnamed slough, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 21, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.82 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,210 feet North and 2,880 feet East from the intersection of Township line 12 South and 13 South with west line John Baker DLC 58 and 59, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 12 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to October 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987
