## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63695 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Beuford V. Wilson of North Myrtle Box 184, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 863-6562, for the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek, a tributary of Myrtle Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.06 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 23, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.065 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 300 feet South and 850 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 24, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South Range 5 West, WM Section 13 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.7 acres irrigation

and domestic use for one family

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shell be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
